Step 1. Fill up University Pre-Admission Online Enrolment Form under AUTONOMUS courses only on <http://muugadmission.samarth.edu.in>

Step-2. Click on "College Pre-Admission Form" to Register by paying Rs.100/-

- In case of Failure in transaction the students should click on Search Form and Resend.
- Once the Payment is made students will receive an email on registered email id containing their Form No. as User ID and Password.
- Using these credentials student is required to login college preadmission form (It is mandatory for Confirming your admission). Fill up Admission Form Part 1 to 9 and click on Submit and Print button.

Step-3. Click on “**Certificate course**” Fill up google form select any one course from given list in the google form. (It is mandatory for confirming your admission).

- After completion of admission form; save it as PDF and take printout and keep it ready with above documents for offline verification as per the schedule **given in the notice**
- a) **Printout College Admission Form**
- b) **Pre-Admission online Enrolment (University)**
- c) **Self-attested Photocopy of Leaving certificate & Original for verification**
- d) **Self-attested Photocopy (02) of HSC Marksheet and Original Marksheet**
- e) **Self-attested Photocopy (01) of SSC Marksheet and Original Marksheet**
- f) **Self-attested Photocopy of caste certificate, if any and original for verification**
- After physical verification by the college on specified date you will receive an email on registered email id. Then login again on college website; and pay the fees.
- **FEES WILL BE ACCEPTED in ONLINE MODE ONLY.**
- **STUDENTS** should complete pre-admission and admission procedure against in-house quota on or before **20th May, 2025.**
- Students belonging to SC/ST/OBC/VJ/NT/SBC and wish to claim for fee concession as per Govt. Rule; must produce attested copy of caste certificate, Income certificate and domicile certificate from Tehsildar's Office, 75% Attendance Undertaking, Undertaking for Reserve Category students, Declaration from SC category students (If applicable), Declaration for other than SC Category students (If applicable) and should be submitted at the time of verification of documents.
- General Category students whose parent's annual income is below Rs.8 lacs and those who are domicile of state of Maharashtra and who want to claim fee concession should submit income certificate and domicile certificate from Tehsildar's Office for Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shishyavrutti Scheme.

N.B. :-

- 1) Incomplete forms **will not be accepted** under any circumstances.
- 2) All the admissions are Provisional subject to approval from University of Mumbai.
- 3) The students should note that if they fail to take the admission in the above stipulated period; their **claim** as the in-house students for admission **will be cancelled.**
- 4) Admission will be given to In-house students on **FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS** those students who have scored minimum 60% in H.S.C. examinations.

***NEP** - All Admissions to the First Year of Degree Programs and their Academic activities will be as per the provisions and guidelines of **NEP 2020** issued by Government of Maharashtra, University of Mumbai and University Grant Commission from time of time
