जय भवानी, जय शिवाजी

आज आपण त्या महापुरुषाबद्दल बोलणार आहोत, ज्यांच्या जन्मामुळे महाराष्ट्र घडला... आणि मराठी माणूस अभिमानाने उभा राहिला. त्या महान योद्ध्याचं नाव छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराज.

१६३० साली शिवनेरी किल्ला. तेथील वाऱ्यात एक चैतन्य होतं, जणू स्वराज्य जन्म घेणार होतं. याच पवित्र भूमीत, फाल्गुन वद्य त्रयोदशीला, जिजाऊंच्या पोटी एका तेजस्वी पुत्राचा जन्म झाला - शिवबा !

शिवबाचं बालपण साधं नव्हतं. त्यांच्या आयुष्यात खेळण्यांची जागा तलवारींनी घेतली होती, आणि गोष्टी सांगणाऱ्या पुस्तकांऐवजी रामायण-महाभारत यांसारख्या ग्रंथांनी. लहान वयातच त्यांनी पराक्रम, धर्म आणि न्याय यांचा अर्थ समजून घेतला होता.

या शिवबाला घडवलं त्यांची माय राजमाता जिजाऊंनी. त्या फक्त आई नव्हत्या, त्या एक शिक्षक होत्या, एक नेता होत्या. त्यांनी शिवबाच्या मनात 'स्वराज्य' हे बीज रुजवलं.

शिवाजी महाराज फक्त तलवारी चालवणारे योद्धे नव्हते. त्यांना रणनीती, गनिमी कावा, किल्ल्यांचे आराखडे, आणि सैन्यव्यवस्था यांचं सखोल ज्ञान होतं.

आपण शिवाजी महाराजांना केवळ युद्धांपुरते ओळखतो, पण हे फार थोड्या लोकांना माहीत आहे की, शिवाजी महाराजांना शेतीचंही अतिशय चांगलं ज्ञान होतं. त्यांना शेतकऱ्यांचं दुःख कळत होतं. म्हणूनच त्यांनी शेतकऱ्यांवर लुटमाराला बंदी घातली, आणि अनेक पाणंद, बंधारे, तलाव बांधून शेतीला चालना दिली. त्यांनी महसूल व्यवस्थेत सुधारणाही केल्या.

शिवाजी महाराजांनी आयुष्यभर अनेक गडकिल्ले जिंकले -सांगायचं तर ३५० हून अधिक किल्ल्यांवर भगवा फडकवला. पण यातील एकही विजय केवळ तलवारीच्या जोरावर नव्हता. त्यामागे होती - त्यांची धोरणं, मुत्सद्देगिरी, आणि जनतेवरील प्रेम.

ते महान राजा होते, ज्यांनी ३५० किल्ले जिंकले, पण एकाही किल्ल्याला स्वतःचं नाव दिलं नाही. ते स्वतः 'राजा' असतानाही ते खरयम स्वतःला 'रफतेचा सेवक'च म्हणायचे. असा राजा मिळणं हे महाराष्ट्राचं खऱ्या अर्थाने भाग्य आहे.

शिवाजी महाराज प्रत्येक स्त्रीचा मान ठेवत असत. त्यांच्या दृष्टिकोनात स्त्री ही मातेसमान असते. त्यांची शिकवण होती - "शत्रूपक्षातील स्त्रीसुद्धा शत्रू नसते, ती देखील मातेसमान असते."

आजकल आपल्या समाजात ज्या प्रकारे मुलीसोबत अत्याचार, बलात्कार होत आहेत, त्या काळातही काही घटनांचा धोका असायचाच. पण शिवाजी महाराजांच्या काळात जर अशा प्रकारची घटना घडली, तर त्यावर तात्काळ आणि कठोर कारवाई व्हायचीच. त्यामुळे अशा प्रकारांना फारशी संधीच मिळत नसे. त्यांच्या काळात खऱ्या अर्थाने स्त्री सुरक्षित होती -आणि हेच होतं खऱ्या अर्थाने स्वराज्य.

त्यांच्या स्वराज्यात समान न्याय, स्त्रियांना सन्मान, आणि धर्मनिरपेक्षता होती. त्यांचं स्वराज्य म्हणजे केवळ भूभागावरचं राज्य नव्हते - ते मनावरचं राज्य होतं.

आज आपण मोकळेपणाने 'मी मराठी आहे', असं अभिमानाने म्हणतो... याचं श्रेय जर कुणाला द्यायचं असेल, तर ते फक्त छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांना.

ते नसते, तर आज महाराष्ट्राचं स्वरूप वेगळं असतं. मराठी अस्मिता, मराठी शौर्य आणि मराठी संस्कृती - या सान्यांचं मूळ शिवाजी महाराजांच्यांमध्ये आहे.

शेवटी फक्त एवढंच म्हणावं वाटतं:- "छत्रपती शिवाजी महाराजांमुळेच आज महाराष्ट्र आहे... आणि मराठी माणूस आहे."
