1. Login Trend

June-2025: 651 logins (lowest)	July-2025: Jump to 3,845 logins
Aug-2025: Slight dip to 3,716	Sep-2025: Peak at 4,173

 **Overall: Steady growth after June, showing increasing digital engagement.**


2. Issue (Books/Resources Issued)

June-2025: 240 issues (lowest)	July-2025: Big rise to 1,084
Aug-2025: Slight dip to 1,006	Sep-2025: Further rise to 1,183 (highest)

 **Pattern: After orientation / semester start, usage surged. September shows maximum borrowing activity.**

3. Return

June-2025: 328 returns	July-2025: 948 (3× increase)
Aug-2025: 983 (highest)	Sep-2025: 979 (slight dip, but still strong)

 **Observation: Return rate closely follows issue trend, meaning students are timely returning materials.**

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4. Total Transactions (Login + Issue + Return)

June-2025: 1,219 (lowest)	July-2025: 5,877
Aug-2025: 5,705	Sep-2025: 6,335 (highest)

📌 **Insight:** Overall library activity increased 5× from June to September, showing semester momentum and effective usage.

5. Key Highlights

- **Lowest Activity:** June (start of academic term, fewer students engaged).
- **Highest Activity:** September (peak academic workload, project/report preparation time).
- **Consistent Growth:** Logins and Issues show strong upward trend → Students are increasingly dependent on library resources.
- **Balanced Circulation:** Returns are almost equal to issues each month, reflecting a healthy circulation cycle.

✓ **Conclusion:**

The data indicates that **library usage has grown steadily across the semester**, peaking in September. Engagement with e-resources (logins) and physical/digital circulation (issues & returns) is strong, highlighting the library's central role in academic activities.
