ABOUT KRIDA MAHOTSAV

Kridamahostav is organised by Gymkhana committee of Sheth NKTT College, Thane. It includes variety of games such as Indoor Games (Table Tennis, Carrom and Chess) and Outdoor Games Box cricket (Men & Women) and Volleyball (Men & Women). Kridamahostav creates an opportunities to encourage the sportsmanship and fight for the hunger to win.



GENERAL RULES

- All members representing any team should be from the same college. If any non-college member is found, the whole team will be disqualified.
- All players should carry the Valid ID cards of their respective colleges.
- One player can play in one team only, registration/playing in multiple teams is not allowed. (For Team Games).
- In Individual sports, students can participate in multiple games.
- Teams not arriving/reporting for their match as per scheduled time, a walkover will be awarded to the opposite team 5 min after the previous game is over.
- If in case any player or team member is found to be in arguments with the referee/opposite team members/committee member, it could result in the team being disqualified from the tournament. No abusive language will be tolerated on the ground premises. If done so the points will be deducted from the college's total points.
- Teams will also be responsible for the misbehaviour (wrongful act) of their supporters at the venue. If the fans of any team invade the field of play, damage any property, or behave in any unruly manner, strict disciplinary action will be taken. They have to bear the cost for the damage.
- Medical kits and first aid will be readily available at the tournament.
- The decision of the organising committee & referee in all matters will be final and binding in any case.
- If required, the management committee has all the rights to change/alter any schedule without prior intimation to the team Captains or the Point of Contact (POC) of that particular college.
- They also have the right to accommodate the dates of the tournament scheduled.
- Changes and upgradation in rules, if any, will be informed on the day of tournament.
- The general rules apply to each & every game, it is essential to adhere to the specific rules designated for each individual game.

REGISTRATION RULES

- Registration can be done in both online mode & offline mode (on the spot) registrations will only be allowed with permission of the Refree/Core committee of kridamahotsav.
- Online registrations will be done through Google form and will be closed on 28th January 2028 at 09:00 PM.
- Participation is open for Junior college students as well.
- Students doing online payments have to fill up the registration form failing to which they won't get entry to the competition and no refund will be initiated to the players.
- In case of cash payment, for on the spot registrations kindly bring the exact denominations as per fees as no change will be provided.
- Students doing online registrations have to attach screenshot of payment and mention UPI transaction ID in the Registration form.
- Online registered students have to carry valid ID cards for academic year 2025-26 and produce their payment screenshot and hardcopy as well at the counter for collecting token.
- Students can register for multiple events and can pay the registration fees together in one transaction.
- Tokens for all the events will be issued at registration counter.
- In any of the case if the ID cards of participants are found to be false/fraudulent it will lead to the disqualification from the event and in such cases refund of registration fees will not be given & strict actions will be taken to that participant.

Carrom

Type of Participation : Individual

Entry fees : Rs 200/- Venue : MMS - Gymkhana (7th Floor) Time : 9:00 am

RULES

Cash Prizes : 1st - 1,500/- , 2nd - 1,000/- , 3rd - 750/-

- Seating:** Each player sits on one side of the board and can only strike from that side.
- Colour:** Players can only pocket their chosen colour token.
- Turns:** The white player takes the first turn. Players get an extra turn for each carrom man pocketed.
- Fouls:** Players lose their turn or return a carrom man to the board for committing a foul.
- Striker:** The striker must touch both base lines while taking a stroke.
- Communication :** Partners in doubles cannot communicate with each other.
- Body:** Crossing the arrow with any part of the body is a technical foul.
- Chair:** Players can't move their chair once their turn has started.

Other rules include:

- The colour of a player's piece is determined by a coin toss. Sinking an opponent's piece results in losing the turn.
- Sinking an opponent's last piece results in losing the board and three points.

Sinking a player's last piece before the queen results in losing the board, three points, and one point for each remaining opponent piece.

Rules

- Match will be played according to "Elimination" basis
- Round: Knocked out
- Time control: 5 min plus 3 sec. increment per player.
- The break: In case of a tie, the result will be resolved in the order.
- 3 min blitz round
- The Chief Arbiter Decision is final and binding to all players.
- During any dispute, the player should report to the arbiter immediately. Once the game is over and the result is submitted, no dispute shall be resolved.

Type of Participation : Individual

Entry Fees : Rs. 300/- Venue : NKT Sabhagrugh (HALL) Time : 09:00 AM

Cash Prizes : 1st - 2,500/- , 2nd - 1,500/- , 3rd - 1,000/-

Rules

- Winner is the first to win 11 points.
- If the score is 10-10, then the game continues until one of the players has gained a lead of 2 points and the dues will continue till the 15 point and 16 th point will be the golden point.
- Points are won irrespective of who has served.
- All the Matches will be the best of 3.
- If the ball touches the net and goes over, it's a 'let' - retake the serve.
- If the ball hits the net and doesn't crosses or flies off the table without bouncing on your opponent's side, participant lose the point.
- The ball should be rest freely on the open palm of the server, above the level of the table.
- In singles participants can serve from anywhere through the table and can target anywhere they want.
- Participant has to change serves every 2 points.
- If the score reaches 10-10 serve changes every point.
- General rules of Table Tennis will be followed.

BOX CRICKET (Men)


Type of Participation: Team

Rules

Cash Prizes : 1st - 10,000/- , 2nd - 7,500/- , 3rd - 5,000/-

- All matches including Finals will be played for 4 overs per innings.
- Each team can play with a maximum of 8 (in team) +2 (substitute) players.
- Sports shoes are compulsory.
- In case the match is unable to start due to the non-availability of any team / team member the umpires will have an option to ask the team of limited members to start the match.
- The match with a reduced side given that the remaining player will report to the college before the next match.
- No extension of time will be given under any circumstances except emergencies.
- If both teams fail to report for the scheduled match, the Krida Mahotsav committee will disqualify the teams.
- In case a team fails to turn up for their scheduled match, the umpires will award the match to the opponent team.
- Any no-ball will result in a free hit (Only boundaries will be consider, sixes are not allowed)
- Byes, Leg byes and Overthrows runs are allowed.
- If the ball goes outside the box except for the boundary, it will be declared as 1 run. The same batsman will play the next ball.
- The innings break for all the matches would be 2 minutes maximum.
- One bowler is allowed to bowl one over only.
- Both feet must be placed on the ground during the bowling.

Volleyball (Men & Women)


Type of Participation: Team

Rules

Cash Prizes : 1st - 5,000/- , 2nd - 3,500/- , 3rd - 2,500/-

- 6+6 (6 in team maximum 6 substitutes)
- All the matches will be played in service fixed rotation
- Set will be played in Best of 3 format with 15 Point each set
- Matches of 3rd Place , Semi Final & Final will played same as Best of 3 Format with 25 point each set
- Refree's decision will be final decision (Arguments will Refree's will lead to direct disqualified by the Gymkhana Committee)
- The number of players in volleyball is six on each side, with the teams separated by a net in the middle.
- The team that wins the pre-game coin toss gets the opportunity to serve the ball first. The aim of the server is to hit the ball over the net from behind the baseline over to the opposition's team half to start a rally.
- Each rally is played for a point and the team that wins the rally and scores a point gets to serve for the next point.
- If the game is tied at 24-24, or 14-14 in the fifth set, the set continues till one team builds a two-point lead over the other.
