**Post Matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities 2026-27
(Government of India – Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities)**

The scheme of **Post Matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities 2026-27** is Central Sector scheme and will be implemented directly by the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). The Post Matric Scholarship for Students with Disabilities is online Scheme and one can apply for fresh or renewal Scholarship under this Scheme on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) at <https://scholarships.gov.in>. The last date for applying online is **31/08/2026**. The sanctioned amount of scholarship (Course/tuition fee and maintenance allowance) will be directly transferred by the Central Government to Aadhar linked Bank Account (Under DBT Mode) of the student.

Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

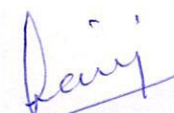
- 1) The scholarship is open to nationals of India only.
- 2) The scholarship is applicable to students with disabilities **with 40% and above** and having a valid certificate of disability as prescribed under the rules issued by the competent authority.
- 3) Not more than two children with disabilities of the same parents will be entitled to receive benefits of the scheme. Provided in case the second child is a twin, the scholarship under this scheme will be admissible to both the twins.
- 4) Scholarship for studying in any class will be available for only one year. If a student has to repeat a class, he/she would not get scholarship for that class for a second or subsequent year.
- 5) A scholarship holder under this scheme will not hold any other scholarship/stipend.
- 6) The annual income of parents/guardians from all sources does not exceed Rs.2.50 lakh.
- 7) Scholarship will be awarded to the students who was passed in the previous final examination.
- 8) The sanctioned amount of scholarship will be directly transferred by the Central Government to Aadhar linked Bank Account (Under DBT Mode) of the student.
- 9) If a student is found to have obtained a scholarship by false statement, his/her scholarship will be cancelled forthwith and the amount of the scholarship paid will be recovered from the student.

Essential documents required :

- 1) Student Photo
- 2) Disability Certificate **with 40% and above** as prescribed under the rules issued by the competent authority.
- 3) An Income Certificate, issued from a Competent Authority in the State/UT Governments is required in respect of parent/guardian of the student.
- 4) Attested Mark Sheet
- 5) Fee Receipt of 'Current Course Year' and Bonafide Certificate from College
- 6) Xerox copy of Adhar linked Bank Account number of the Student along with the IFSC Code of the bank branch
- 7) Attested copy of Ration Card & Leaving Certificate

Procedure for Applying :

- 1) The scheme is implemented through the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.
- 2) Before applying online; the students are asked to go through the detailed instructions for filling in online application and 'Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)' on the National Scholarship Portal Homepage.
- 3) The Applicant can contact college office for resolving the problem occurred while filling the online form.
- 4) After filling the online form, the applicant is required to take a print out of the online form and submit it in the college office **on or before 31/08/2026** for further process with the relevant necessary documents as mentioned above.
